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## Crop Rotation

Crop rotation should be practiced in all gardens, particularly vegetable gardens. It is a method of preventing the spread of diseases (or insect pests) which may attack vegetables belonging to the same group or family.

If disease in any crop is serious, it would be unwise to plant a closely related crop in the same bed several seasons in a row owing to the possibility of disease transmission to similar crops.

In theory, also, it is probable that planting the same plants or families in the same spot year after year is inadvisable as the supply of some nutrients will become depleted if they are always in demand from the same group of plants. Of course, supplementary fertilizing should easily correct this problem.

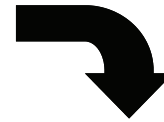
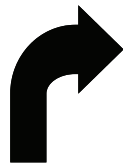

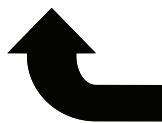
